How to purchase Windows for your business

Microsoft offers several ways to purchase software and devices for your business

How to purchase multiple software licenses

If you need multiple software licenses contact a partner.

How to purchase multiple devices

If you are looking to buy several devices, you can find a partner or work directly with the Microsoft Store Sales team.

1 - Requires InstantGo or device that passes the device encryption HCK test

2 - Requires TPM 1.2 or greater for TPM based key protection.

3 - Cortana is available only in certain markets; Experience may vary by region and device; Requires Microsoft Account to use

4 - Windows Hello requires specialized hardware, including fingerprint reader, illuminated IR sensor or other biometric sensors

5 - Requires touch screen capabilities; App experiences may vary
